The fire which started 10 miles from our property raged through forestation and arrived onto our vineyards, winery, orchard and our home, which is located on a total of 209 acres.

Over 2,000 firefighters fought this forceful fire with heroic measures. Although our home, winery and vineyards did not burn to the ground and the structures remained intact, we had severe smoke and fire retardant damage which extended over a 20 acre area covering our residence and winery.
